We're thrilled to have them on board and part of our Chautauqua Lake family.

On the academic front, we're very proud to share exciting results from the spring 2025 New York State assessments (Grades 3–8 ELA, Math, and Science) and Regents exams. Preliminary data shows that our district made gains in nearly every area compared to the previous year—a direct result of the hard work and collaboration of our students, families, teachers, and staff. These results will put us once again at the top of the regional rankings!

To build on that success, our educators have spent the summer updating our Elementary and Secondary building priorities. These priorities, aligned with our district-wide goals, will guide our work in the months ahead. In the first few weeks of September, our teachers will set meaningful individual and team goals to help move our district forward. Last year, we met **97% of our 155 goals**, a 6% increase from the previous year—an achievement we're very proud of.

In terms of facilities, our campus is looking better than ever. A few highlights include:

- · A refurbished stadium scoreboard
- A brand-new outdoor softball and baseball batting cage
- Fresh sealing and coating of the main parking lot

These improvements ensure that our learning and extracurricular spaces are welcoming and well-maintained.

We also want to share positive news about our district's long-term financial stewardship. From the 2021–22 school year to the upcoming 2025–26 year, the **school tax rate has decreased from \$8.63 to \$6.55 per \$1,000 of full value.** That's a **reduction of \$2.08**, or over **24%**, thanks to responsible budgeting and careful planning—all while continuing to deliver high-quality educational opportunities. Our school tax rate is the lowest in the entire county.

We're deeply grateful for the ongoing support of our community. The collective efforts of our staff, families, Board of Education, and administration have helped us become one of the top school districts in Western New York. We will continue to strive to make the best possible educational environment for our students!
