




Committee Decision: Remove the logo (Thunderbird far right D zone in pic above) and replace with pitching mounds and provide an area for baseball/softball practice.

FRONT SIGN




Discussion about funding implications if we wait or use something existing.

Group Consensus: Hold on changing, but push the other committee to make a design timely to try and use funding.


Will attempt to make this #1 priority once decision made on mascot. May not make capital project deadline....




Status: See change above. Is everyone okay with this change?



Essential Question is everyone ok with putting Chautauqua Lake where it said Thunderbird Cafe?




Status: Signage has been removed and the tiles are replaced.

Group Consensus: Remove and replace tiles; possibly use new logo in the future if cost/time permits



Status: The logo will be removed and the wall panels will be replaced with light grey to match. The lead times for these panels are 6-8 weeks.

GYMNASIUM SCOREBOARD



Status: The new scoreboards will both have "CHAUTAUQUA LAKE" on the top and bottom panels. The logo above the scores will be removed and replaced with a blank navy panel. The project team has approved this change proposal and will be scheduled with the contractor.

Expedited Timeline (see attachment):

The following is the timeline for the transition plan:

June-August 2023:

- CL Leadership Team will identify and select members for the CL Campus & CL Design Committees.
- CL Campus Committee will identify and create a prioritized list of areas that have the term "Thunderbird" depicted and aligned imagery.
- CL Campus Committee will work to devise strategies to remove and/or replace the "Thunderbird" name and imagery.

September-December 2023:

- Creation of CL Design Committee.
- The Design Committee will develop strategies to gather feedback and ideas from various school community members.
- CL Design Committee will accumulate feedback from the school community, including students, parents, employees and board members to narrow down the list of possible nicknames.
- CL Design Committee will devise a method by which a new nickname will be selected.
- CL Design Committee will recommend a new nickname to the BOE no later than December 31, 2023.

July 2023 -June, 2024

• The CL Campus Committee will use a prioritized list to begin to replace "Thunderbird" imagery and nickname by June 30, 2024.

July 2024-June, 2025

• Remove any remaining "Thunderbird" graphics and imagery and/or replace it with the new nickname by June 30, 2025.
