Late Fall/Early Winter: Dec. 1st: Proposed Addition of Part 123 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education Relations to Prohibiting the Use of Indigenous Names, Mascots, and Logos by Public Schools

May 18th, 2023: Release of written guidance interpreting the new regulations regarding the State's prohibition on school districts using Indigenous nicknames.


Mascot/Advisory Committee: Round 2/List



Essential Questions: Use compass logo? Or provide a practice area for baseball/softball.


Endzones: LAKE?



Status: Final decision will come down to the timing of the new logo. Currently the leadership team has the change proposal for this work


We may be able to use capital project funding if the logo is changed in November.







Status: The Thunderbirds verbiage will be removed and left blank. This work has been scheduled with the contractor.



Expedited Timeline (see attachment):

The following is the timeline for the transition plan:

June-August 2023:

- CL Leadership Team will identify and select members for the CL Campus & CL Design Committees.
- CL Campus Committee will identify and create a prioritized list of areas that have the term "Thunderbird" depicted and aligned imagery.
- CL Campus Committee will work to devise strategies to remove and/or replace the "Thunderbird" name and imagery.

September-December 2023:

- Creation of CL Design Committee.
- The Design Committee will develop strategies to gather feedback and ideas from various school community members.
- CL Design Committee will accumulate feedback from the school community, including students, parents, employees and board members to narrow down the list of possible nicknames.
- CL Design Committee will devise a method by which a new nickname will be selected.
- CL Design Committee will recommend a new nickname to the BOE no later than December 31, 2023.

July 2023 -June, 2024

• The CL Campus Committee will use a prioritized list to begin to replace "Thunderbird" imagery and nickname by June 30, 2024.

July 2024-June, 2025

• Remove any remaining "Thunderbird" graphics and imagery and/or replace it with the new nickname by June 30, 2025.
