

Goals that Anchor Decision Making

 - Chautauqua Lake, rural setting, Mayville/Chautauqua merger, Ripley partnership
- Nickname represents aspects of our school values and culture
 - High expectations: "Culture of Excellence," "Destination District," "Charting a Course for the Future"
- What are some more Anchor points?



Final Selection Process

- Design Committee will **select two nicknames** that align to the pre-established anchor points.
 - On 9/20, we will create a pros/cons list for each of the submitted nicknames to help us select two nicknames.
 - Working with CPL design a imagery that aligns with selected names presented to 10/3 or 10/12.
- Students will be voting and will be responsible for final decision.
 - Use nickname and corresponding imagery on Google Form for voting
 - What grade levels/students should be voting?
- How will results be celebrated and shared?
