#### WHAT YOU WILL BE VOTING ON

**Budget Proposition:** Resolved, that the budget for the Chautauqua Lake Central School District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted in the amount of \$23,202,347 and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the said District to be levied and collected as required by law.

**Voting for School Board Members:** Three "three year term" board seats will be filled this year. Candidates who have filed the required board petition as of the May 11, 2020, deadline will appear on the ballot in alphabetical order. They are: Travis Bensink, Gina Hardenburg, Melissa Putney, Zach Stahlsmith and Mary Lee Talbot. All candidates are running "at large," and the three candidates with the highest number of votes shall be declared elected.

### **CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT**
