

Indoor Air Quality

THERMAL CONFORT

Pre-set temperature range is 70–72°.




Number shows actual room temp.



Warmer/Cooler buttons adjust the temp by 2 degrees from the computer set-point.



After school hours, push Manual On button ONCE to reset to daytime temp for about an hour.



GREEN LIGHT indicates you have selected daytime temp for about an hour.



After temperature sets back again in about an hour, you may repeat to reset to daytime temperature for another hour.



After school hours, press Manual On only ONCE to reset to daytime temperature; repeat as needed each time temperature sets back (about an hour later)

Use blinds to control heat from sunlight



...keep windows closed...



...keep doors closed too



VENTILATION

Know where air supply vents are...



...and test to be sure they're working



Know where air returns are... ... and test them, too



Fume hoods need to be tested...

What to look for

GENERAL CLEANLINESS

Is your room dusted and vacuumed thoroughly and regularly?



Is trash...



... removed daily?



Make sure food is NOT kept in classroom



Store animal food tightly sealed



Look for signs of pests



Do not use scented air fresheners



Do not use scented cleaners



For spills on carpets, contact custodians immediately!



Run water in sinks every week



Check for leaks...



...and signs of moisture



ANIMALS



Locate animals away from vents



Plants can be a source of problems, too




ART & SCIENCE SUPPLIES
